Discussion Questions

- **1.** Peres had the longest-running political career in Israel's history. What do you think made him such a successful and popular politician?
- 2. Some claim that it was Peres's naive optimism that led to the signing of the Oslo Accords. Is it possible to be overly optimistic? How does one find balance between optimism/dreaming and pragmatism?
- **3.** World leaders flew to Israel to attend Peres's funeral, including U.S. President Barack Obama, former U.S. president Bill Clinton, Prince Charles, French president Francois Hollande, Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, German President Joachim Gauck, and even Palestinian Authority president Mahmoud





Abbas. What did the international community see in Peres that made him a dear friend to many?

- **4.** Read a few Peres quotes here. What insights did you gain about him, Israel, or life in general?
- **5.** Break up into five groups and engage in a <u>jigsaw activity</u>. Compare and contrast these leaders of Israel: <u>Menachem Begin, David Ben-Gurion, Yitzhak Rabin, Golda Meir</u>, and <u>Moshe Dayan</u>. What made them similar to one another? How are they different from each other?

Reflection Questions

- **1.** What quality of Peres's do you most admire? Explain.
- 2. If you had the opportunity to speak to Peres, what would you like to ask him?
- **3.** Peres once said, "Every day I wake up and I count my achievements. And then I count the dreams I have in my head. As long as I have more dreams in my head than achievements, I am young." What did he mean by this? To you, what does it mean to be a dreamer?
- **4.** After viewing this video and the <u>video about Operation Thunderbolt</u>, whose leadership style do you identify with more, Rabin's or Peres's?
- **5.** Peres was also a poet, known to pen lines during slow meetings. In his spirit, write a poem about Israel on a topic dear to you.
- **G.** When thinking of these leaders of Israel: Menachem Begin, David Ben-Gurion, Yitzchak Rabin, Golda Meir, and Moshe Dayan, do you think we've moved past the era of Israel's heroic leaders? Read this article, watch our videos, and reflect on your perspective on this issue.
